

## Craven County Law Enforcement Officers Association

### Minutes July 13, 2021

The board meeting was opened at 1200 hours. Present were the President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer and 62 members. Allegiance was pledged to our flag and a moment of silence was observed for those who stand for us. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The treasurer's report noted a balance of \$23,283.35. All accounts were current as of 13 July. Membership stood at 458. Our debt service is up to date. **Motion was made to accept the report, seconded, and approved.**

**Maintenance** – Dale reported that all required work is up to date. Be reminded that, unless needed work is reported, it cannot be done.

**Fund Raising** – \$55.00 was generated last month.

**Safety** – Additional personnel are needed for safety officer training.

**By-Laws** – Remaining items, by-laws, etc, which needed to be read for the third time were presented and a **motion was made to accept same. It was seconded and approved.** Copies are attached to this report.

**Unfinished Business** – Conversation concerning the redevelopment of the web site continued. A site developer has been chosen and the arrangements provide for a cost of \$2,420, to be paid in two billings. The process will take six to eight weeks and carry a \$49./month charge. Steve Adams will have full access to the system. **Motion was made to employ the above, it was seconded and accepted by the membership.** A plea was made for two additional volunteers to work the system.

Jimmy asked for additional volunteers to assist in lawn cutting.

Meal service was the next topic and following discussion it was decided that, on a monthly basis, one may volunteer to work the following month. The meal may be whatever the volunteer wishes and should be planned for 50 people. Dona Baker stepped forward for August. Dennis Driver agreed to maintain kitchen supplies.

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New Business – A question was asked for clarification of the future costs of the automated gates and their function. Each member needs to provide the last four numbers of their SS#. This will be the basis of their future ID and gate pass. Immediate costs will add to about \$10K. with a future addition of another \$5K.

The following were presented for membership: Anthony Fischer, Earl Higgins, Anthony Calise, James Carson, Vincent Pedulla, Eric Reese, Allen Klemmer, and Gary Goudace. Their acceptance was **Moved, seconded and approved.**
